Construction Update: May 19-June 13



Temporary Full Closure of 6th Street Begins Next Week

On Monday, May 19, plan ahead for a temporary, full closure of 6th Street from Maple Street through the intersection of Pine Street. This road closure aims to expedite project completion and to support the long term durability of street improvements.

See the detailed map to the left that indicates detour routes and temporary customer parking locations. Below is a general outline of what to expect:

Anticipated Schedule:

Dates are subject to change.

May 19 - May 29:

Full closure of 6th Street from Maple Street to Pine Street

For demolition of Pine & 6th Street intersection, installation of conduit and concrete, and demolition in front of the Himalayan Cafe

May 27 - June 13:

Expanded full closure of 6th Street from Roundabout to Pine Street

For demolition East of Pine Street on 6th Street, installation of conduit and concrete, paving and striping

June 13:

6th Street back open to traffic & on-street parking


What to expect for the next few weeks:

- Neighborhood residents and business owners/managers are invited to join the project team on Thursday, May 15 @ 10 a.m. at the Hotel Colorado to review the proposed detour plan and ask any questions.
- The east end of 6th Street from Maple St. through the intersection of Pine St. will be closed to through traffic beginning on May 19th. After May 27th, the street will be closed to through traffic beginning at the roundabout. Pedestrians will still be able to access the east end of the Pine Street crossing in front of the Hotel Colorado throughout the closure.
- Business access will remain open with slight detours! No businesses will lose delivery access, but businesses should alert delivery personnel about the closure. Delivery trucks will be able to pull into the closure just east of Maple Street.
- Alley access to the southside businesses will remain open during the closure for employees and residents of these buildings.
